ORDINANCE NO. 727

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE
OF SURPLUS PROPERTY
OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF WARRENSBURG, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Warrensburg ("Village"), it is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of the Village, to retain the property described in Section 2 and Section 3 below; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Village to expeditiously dispose of the property set forth in Section 2 and Section 3 pursuant to the authority granted to the Village by the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 (2011).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the President and the Trustees of the Village of Warrensburg, Macon County, Illinois:

Section 1. Recitals Incorporated. The above recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance and shall have the same force and effect as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Fluorescent Light Fixtures. Pursuant to section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village finds, that continued ownership is no longer necessary or useful to the Village, or for the best interests of the Village to retain ownership of twenty-four (24) fluorescent light fixtures.

Section 3. Sale of Fixtures. The fixtures set forth in Section 2 above, shall be sold "as-is" by delivering to Cody Redman Auctioneer Service Inc., of Decatur, Illinois, for consignment sale at public auction, to the highest bidder or bidders.

Section 4. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All existing ordinances of the Village of Warrensburg are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. The Village Clerk of the Village of Warrensburg shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published in pamphlet form and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in pamphlet form as so certified.


