ORDINANCE NO. 737

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 8, CHAPTER 6,
SECTION 9, ENTITLED
“WASTEWATER SERVICE CHARGES”**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF WARRENSBURG, ILLINOIS:

Section 1:

THAT Title 8, Chapter 6, Section 8-6-9 (I)-(O) is hereby amended by deleting Paragraphs (I) through and including (O) and adding new language to read as follows:

(I) BASIC USER CHARGE:

There shall be and there is hereby established a basic user charge of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) per one thousand (1,000) gallons of metered water consumption to be applied to all users to recover OM&R costs.

(J) DEBT SERVICE CHARGE:

There shall be and there is hereby established a debt service charge of zero dollars (\$0.00) per one thousand (1,000) gallons to each user of the wastewater facility.

(K) CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT CHARGE:

There shall be and there is hereby established a capital improvement charge of Fifty Cents (\$0.50) per month to each user of the wastewater facility.

(L) RATES:

A minimum basic user charge of Eleven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$11.50) per month shall be applied to all users whose water consumption does not exceed one thousand (1,000) gallons per month. This minimum charge consists of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) for OM&R costs, zero dollars (\$0.00) for debt service costs and Fifty Cents (\$0.50) for capital improvement costs.

Usage in excess of one thousand (1,000) gallons per month will be charged at a rate of Three Dollars and Seventy Five cents (\$3.75) per one thousand (1,000) gallons.

The monthly wastewater service charge for the Warrensburg Latham Community Unit School District 11 shall be determined upon the basis of average gallons of water used per month and shall include a minimal charge of Nine Hundred Eighty dollars (\$980.00) for two hundred thousand (200,000) gallons or less per month with usage in excess of two hundred thousand gallons (200,000) charged at a rate of Three Dollars and Seventy Five

Cents (\$3.75) per thousand (1,000) gallons.

(M) NONMETERED USERS:

All nonmetered residential users of the wastewater facilities shall pay a flat rate charge of Twelve Dollars and Thirty Four Cents (\$12.34) per month paid annually. The flat rate charge consists of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) for OM&R costs, zero dollars (\$0.00) for debt service costs, Fifty Cents (\$0.50) for capital improvement costs, and Eighty Four Cents (\$0.84) for NPDES charge. All nonmetered commercial, industrial, institutional or government users of the wastewater facility shall pay a flat rate charge of Thirteen Dollars and Fifteen Cents (\$13.15) per month paid annually. The flat rate charge consists of Eleven Dollars (\$11.00) for OM&R costs, (\$0.00) for debt service costs, Fifty Cents (\$0.50) for capital improvement costs, and One Dollar and Sixty Five Cents (\$1.65) for NPDES charge. The flat rate charge will allow a maximum of one thousand (1,000) gallons per month.

In the event use of the wastewater facilities is determined by the Superintendent to be in excess of one thousand (1,000) gallons per month, the superintendent may require such flat rate user to install metering devices on the water supply or sewer main to measure the amount of service supplied.

(N) SURCHARGE RATES:

The rates of surcharges for BOD and SS shall be as follows:

Per lb. of BOD: One Dollar and Twenty Cents (\$1.20) for concentration exceeding two hundred milligrams per liter (200 mg/l)

Per lb. of SS: One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) for concentration exceeding two hundred fifty milligrams per liter (250 mg/l)

(O) NPDES CHARGE:

There shall be and is hereby established a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) charge of Eighty Four Cents (\$0.84) per month per residential meter and a NPDES charge of One Dollar and Sixty Five Cents (\$1.65) per month per commercial, industrial, institutional or governmental meter.

(P) COMPUTATION OF WASTEWATER CHARGE:

The Wastewater Service Charge shall be computed by the following formula:

$$CW = [CC + CD + CM + (Vu - X) CU + CS] + CN$$

Where:

CW = Amount of wastewater service charge (\$) per billing period.

CC = Capital Improvement Charge

CD = Debt Service Charge

CM = Minimum Charge for Operation, Maintenance and Replacement

Vu = Wastewater Volume for the billing period

X = Allowable consumption in gallons for the minimum charge

CU = Basic User Charge for Operation, Maintenance and Replacement

CS = Surcharges, if applicable

CN = NPDES Charge

Section 2:

THAT annually, commencing on May, 2020 and each May thereafter, the basic user charge, capital improvement charge, and variable rate for usage in excess of one thousand (1,000) gallons shall each increase by four percent (4%) for all users.


Section 3:


