AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ADVISORY QUESTIONS OF PUBLIC POLICY FOR SUBMISSION ON THE BALLOT FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 17, 2020 REGARDING CANNABIS BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS AND A LEGALLY BINDING QUESTION REGARDING AN INCREASE IN THE POLICE PROTECTION LEVY

WHEREAS, the Village of Warrensburg, Illinois is a municipality as defined in Article VII, Section 1 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.1-40-60 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/3.1-40-60, allows a municipality of the State of Illinois, by a vote of the majority of the members of the Village Board of Trustees to authorize an advisory question of public policy to be placed on the ballot at the next regularly scheduled election in the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois Board of Elections has determined that Monday December 16, 2019, is the last day for municipalities to adopt a resolution to authorize an advisory question of public policy to appear on the ballot for the general election to be held in the Village of Warrensburg on March 17, 2020.

WHEREAS, Section 28-5 of the Illinois Election Code, 10 ILCS 5/28-5, provides for the certification of advisory questions of public policy.

WHEREAS, the Village of Warrensburg wishes to receive public input on the issue of whether cannabis business establishments should be allowed or prohibited within the city limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WARRENSBURG, MACON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That the following questions should be submitted to the voters of the Village as an advisory question of public policy at the general election to be held on March 17, 2020:

Should the Village of Warrensburg, Illinois allow the establishment and operation of an Adult-Use Cannabis Dispensing Organization within Village limits?	YES <input type="checkbox"/> NO <input type="checkbox"/>

Should the Village of Warrensburg, Illinois allow the establishment and operation of Adult-Use Cannabis Dispensary support organizations, including but not limited to, Adult-Use Cannabis Craft Growing, Adult-Use Cannabis Cultivation, Adult-Use Cannabis Infuser, Adult-Use Cannabis Processing, Adult-Use Cannabis Transportation and Storage centers? Section 2: That the following question should be submitted to the voters of the Village of Warrensburg as a legally binding question of public policy that the general election to be held on March 17, 2020:

Section 3: That said questions shall be conducted, in all respects, in accordance with the provisions of the Illinois Election Code pertaining to the conduct of the March 17, 2020 general election.

Section 4: That the Village Administrative Clerk is hereby directed to certify this Ordinance as having been adopted by the Board of Trustees and to file the certified resolution with the Macon County Election Office.

Section 5: That this Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the Village's municipal authority and shall become effective immediately upon its passage, recording and publication in pamphlet form by the Village Administrative Clerk, as provided by law.


